### **ANNUAL REPORT 2022- 2023**

I really feel proud and privileged to stand here on this 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Day. Before I present the School Annual Report for the academic year 2022 -2023, let me extend a warm and hearty welcome you all to 'JINGLE BELLS 2022'.

As you all know proper education has become a necessity for better living in this modern world. Education makes an all round development of one's personality. If education doesn't fulfill this aim, it is not education at all.

For achieving this, teachers play a vital role. The growth and development of this school with in a short time is indeed remarkable. Very impressive strides have been made in different areas. The success of an educational institution is generally measured by the performance of the students in the public examination. But it is equally important that institution [provides them with right environment such as physical, mental and spiritual development. This environment which we provides certainly pave the way for making our pupil's good personalities for the society.

1. **MOTTO:** The aim of the school is to build best all round personalities for the nation. Students should be strong enough in keeping their body, mind and spirit. It also aim at providing value based quality education to all its pupils. Pupils are given individual attention to develop their creativities at the maximum.
2. **ADMISSION AND ROLL STRENGTH:** During the current year 75 pupils joined the school. We have two divisions for LKG,UKG and Classes III,IV.All other classes having one division each.
3. **STAFF:** We have 29 teaching staff,2 office staff and 16 non-teaching staff.
4. **MORNING ASSEMBLY:** We have morning assembly begins with a school prayer song. It is followed by a few regular exercises like pledge, moral stories, news reading in English and Malayalam and thought for the day.

National anthem is sung by school choir in the evening when school activities are over.

5. **ACADEMIC REVIEW:** The current academic year started on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022. Opening function conducted with great pomp and show. The function was inaugurated by the joint Excise commissioner of the state Mr. Renjith. New teachers and students were welcomed to the school.
6. **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS:** We are proud to report that 2021-2022 batch of class X students have brought laurels to the school by their excellent result. We achieved 100% result in CBSE class X examination held in the month of March 2021. Out of 30 students, 6 students got 90% and above in all the subjects. 20 students got distinction and 4 of them secured first class. This glittering result was possible because of the continuous efforts taken by the dedicated staff and by taking extra classes and remedial measures to improve them.
7. **READING WEEK:** Reading week was celebrated with various activities such as essay writing competition, Summary preparation, Quiz etc. One of the Malayalam teachers gave awareness to the students about the importance of P.N Panickars contributions to Malayalam literature.
8. **YOGA DAY:** Yoga day is celebrated on 21<sup>st</sup> June Wednesday by conducting a special assembly. Video of different yogas are projected in front of the students and gave awareness about the benefits of yoga.
9. **ANTI - DRUG DAY:** Anti-drug day is observed on 27<sup>th</sup> June as 26<sup>th</sup> was holiday. Rally also conducted from Kottankulangara junction to Chavara.
10. **DOCTORS DAY:** Doctors day is celebrated on 1<sup>st</sup> July Friday. Medical camp is conducted by Dr. Shambu, the Surgeon of taluk hospital Mavelikara. Free check up for the public also provided.
11. **HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI DAY:** Special assembly conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> August Tuesday to observe Hiroshima and Nagasaki day. Models of sudokku cranes were displayed. The students were given awareness about the importance of August 6 and 9 with story of Sudokku Cranes by a student of class X, Sravya.

12. INDEPENDENCE DAY: Independence day is celebrated with variety of competition. Independence rally conducted from Chavara junction to school. Patriotic song competition also conducted.
13. INVESTITURE: Investiture held on 29<sup>th</sup> August Monday. Mr. Bijulal the Excise Inspector of Karunagapalli inaugurated the program. He made awareness about the leadership quality among the students.
14. ONAM CELEBRATION: Onam celebrated on 1<sup>st</sup> September Thursday with variety of house wise competition such as Pulikali, Onampattu, Tug of war etc and the school closed for onam vacation after the celebration.
15. ARTS FEST: Arts fest held on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The fest was inaugurated by the Mr. Jose Titus, the poet and the writer. The prize winners are selected for Sahodaya arts fest competition.
16. SAHODAYA COMPETITION: 43 students participated in Kollam Sahodaya arts fest competition held in the last week of October at Pallimon Sidardha central school. Most of the participants secured A grade and 3 of them got Second and Third prizes.
17. TREATMENT FUND: Charity is collected from the students for the purpose of treatment of a child in Ayyankoickal. The collected amount is given to the girl by the Manager.
18. KERALAPIRAVI: We celebrated Keralapiravi with various programs such as speech on the birth of Kerala, action song, Traditional dance of Kerala and narrative story telling.
19. CHILDRENS DAY: Childrens day is celebrated on 14<sup>th</sup> November. KG section celebrated kids day on the day of childrens day. Fancy dress of Jawaharlal Nehru and other National leaders are there from the KG section. Variety of programs such as action song, Kids dance etc were also there.
20. PROVERB QUIZ: A bible quiz is conducted in the month of November to develop spiritual awareness among the senior students.
21. SCHOLARSHIP EXAM: We are living in a competitive world. Academic examinations are insufficient to prepare the children for competitive exams. To develop their ability to face the competitive world. We have

- conducted UNIX scholarship exam in the first week of DECEMBER from LKG to class X.
22. EXHIBITION AND FOOD FEST: To develop the creativity and in born talents of the students we conducted science exhibition. Rev. Father James Joy Inagurated the exhibition and food fest together.   24. HOUSE & CLUB ACTIVITIES: Every Thursdays & Fridays we have House and Club activities to improve their creativity and social commitment.
  25. TEACHERS TRAINING PROGRAMME: To empower our teachers, we provide training courses every year. This Year also our teachers attended many offline training programmes and workshops in Oxford School, TKM School , Alappuzha EMS and attended different online training programmes.
  26. EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: We provide Dance, Organ, Violin, Karatte etc on all Wednesdays.
  27. PARENTS CO OPERATION: We are getting whole hearted and sincere co-operation from our parents. Iam very happy that we keep a good and healthy relationship with our parents. They lead as well as guide us for the smooth functioning of our School. We call all our parents to the School to attend all important functions.
